Next week we will be holding an International Week in school. Each class will learn about a different country as follows.

Reception - France Class 1 - New Zealand Nursery - Eritrea Class 2 - India Class 3 - Sri Lanka Class 4 - Switzerland Class 5 - Japan Class 6 - Italy

During the week the children will learn about different aspects of that country such as

- It's location on a map
