### Class News

<u>Nursery</u> Pupils have been having fun dressing up as superheroes and had a wonderful superheroes day where they took part in an assault course and made capes and masks.

<u>Year Four</u> Children had a great three days on their residential at Lineham Farm. They took part in lots of outdoor activities including climbing, team building and animal care and shared their experiences in a lovely assembly. The class recently visited the University for a workshop about bio-diversity and how important bees are to our environment.

<u>Year Five</u> Children have been learning about Brazil and made some colourful headdresses. They have also attended a workshop with the Into University organisation where they learned about engineering. The children had a brilliant time at Herd Farm taking part in lots of outdoor team challenges.

<u>Year Six</u> Pupils had a great session with educational psychologists before their SATs to encourage them to be calm. Their attitude was excellent during the tests and are about to start rehearsals for their summer production. They enjoyed a fabulous trip to Robinwood this week where they learned to climb, abseil, canoe, problem solve and to do archery.
