#### Class News

**Rainbow Class** Pupils have enjoyed the Rumble in the Jungle story and had a great visit to Harlow Carr this term. They have enjoyed weekly sessions to the vinery and their Dancing Tots sessions in school. **Nursery** Children really enjoyed their teddy bears picnic this week. They have grown plants and enjoyed learning lots about lifecycles of plants and insects. They have explored patterns and doubling numbers linked to the minibeasts. They have enjoyed their weekly Dancing Tots sessions and rhythm sticks activities. It was also lovely to meet so many of the parents of children who will be joining reception class and nursery in September.

**Reception** Children had lots of fun at their balance bike workshop and learned how to ride the small bikes confidently. Pupils have hunted minibeasts and found many different insects. They have written some poems about them and enjoyed harvesting the potatoes and green beans that they planted.

<u>Year One</u> Pupils did very well in their phonics check and were able to read the words very confidently. They have been learning about the Great Fire of London and made model houses built close together to watch how the fire spread so quickly in Pudding lane. They also enjoyed their balance bikes sessions. They had a great trip to Harlow Carr where they identified trees and leaves linked to their science topic.

**Year Two** Children had a wonderful day at Lotherton Hall learning all about the habitats of the many birds and animals that live there. As part of their seaside topic, children really enjoyed visiting Filey and looked at the physical features of the coastline. They paddled in the sea, made sandcastles and enjoyed an ice cream. They had an outdoor sports day at Allerton Park, provided by the Yorkshire Children's Charity and had a wonderful time with pupils from other schools.

**Year Three** Pupils have completed a topic about chocolate from how it is grown, made and sold. They had a workshop with a chocolatier who taught them all about the stages from planting to making chocolate and they all made their own lolly. They have studied Mexican folk art and made some wonderful pappier mache models of fantastic creatures.

**Year Four** Pupils enjoyed a day of adventure at Go Ape where they put their climbing skills to the test. The children also completed the times tables check undertaken by all year 4 children. They have worked very hard to learn their tables and all made brilliant progress. They have learned blanket stitch when sewing their purses.

<u>Year Five</u> Pupils had a great day in Ripon spending time with their pen pals and visiting their school and Ripon market in North Yorkshire. They enjoyed a trip to Yeadon Tarn where they experienced canoeing and paddle boarding.

<u>Year Six</u> Class 6 have made some wonderful battery powered carousels in design technology. They have enjoyed trips to a Jewish Synagogue and Holocaust Centre to link with their RE. Children have been to visit their high schools ready for September. The children have their leaver's assembly on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> July at 1.30 pm. We wish them happiness and success as they move to high school. Year 6 parents are invited to attend.

<u>Summer Production</u> It was wonderful to see so many parents at the KS2 production of Matilda this year. The year 6 pupils rose to the occasion and received huge applause from the audience. The singing from the choir was excellent and we were very proud of all the children.

<u>Into University</u> We have been pleased to work with this organisation again this year. They have provided workshops with classes 4-6 to help them understand what university is, explore jobs such as engineering and design and learn about the next stage of their education. The children and staff have really enjoyed the hands on and informative sessions and we look forward to working with them again next year.

**Sports workshops** Each class had wonderful sports workshops that included unihoc, basketball, archery and ultimate Frisbee sessions.

<u>Transition</u> All the children have been given time to meet their new teachers. They heard about topics they will study and trips to look forward to.

**Sports Day** The children had sports day this week and managed to miss most of the rain. They had lots of fun. Thank you to Mrs Higson for her work in organising this.

<u>Parents Group</u> Thank you to all the parents who attended the groups this year. It has been lovely to see how you have supported each other with the learning you have been doing.
