As we break up for Christmas, I would like to share news about recent events in school and let you know about forthcoming events.













#### Class News

<u>Rainbow Class</u> The children are working hard on learning their phonics and have been sharing the story of Handa's Surprise. They are also enjoying using the apparatus in PE and visiting the Vinery Centre for adventurous play sessions.

<u>Nursery</u> Children have been enjoying the story We're Going on a Bear Hunt. They have retold the story with lots of props and had lots of fun. They had an exciting visit from our local police who brought their van for the children to learn about.

<u>Reception</u> Children have really enjoyed learning about the Christmas Story and re-telling it to each other. They also rode on the Santa express train during their trip to Middleton Railway where they all met and received a present from Santa. The children visited Leeds Minster to see the life size nativity figures and learn about the very first Christmas.

<u>Year One</u> They had a brilliant visit to Skelton Grange where they explored the natural environment and learned all about wildlife and made crafts using natural materials.

<u>Year Two</u> During the last half term children learned all about the history of the gunpowder plot and had a visit from an archaeologist who shared artefacts to bring the history alive. The children had a wonderful visit to Abbey House Museum to learn about old toys as part of their history.

<u>Year Three</u> Pupils had a wonderful day on their Stone Age visit at Skelton Grange where they hunted, cooked and ate food around an open fire.

<u>Year Four</u> Pupils enjoyed a workshop all about Ancient Egypt at the Leeds City Museum. They recounted their experiences in some excellent writing. As part of RE the class visited Scott Hall Church to learn about the beginning of Christianity. They listened well to the talk and enjoyed a quiz all about what they had learned. Classes 4 and 5 took part in a STEM workshop with a range of different engineers where they learned about the kind of jobs they could do and designed some playground equipment.

<u>Year Five</u> Children entered a space dome to experience the many planets in the galaxy as part of their science topic all about the solar system. It really immersed them in their learning.

Classes 5 and 6 had a visit from our local Police to talk about the dangers of bonfire night and how to keep safe.

<u>Year Six</u> Children had a visit from the Bikeability team this half term and by the end of the week every child could ride their bike confidently. They also had a workshop run by the Tender Project which explores healthy relationships and what makes a good friend. It was really helpful and will support the pupils as they move into high school. Six pupils in the class attended the Dodgeball Championship and beat 12 other schools to win the enormous trophycongratulations to them all!

<u>Lateness</u> We still have some pupils who are late to school each morning. Please be ready in the playground with your children at 8.30 am so that they start on time.
