International Week - Monday 19th October

Next week we will be holding an International Week in school. Each class will learn about a different country as follows.

Nursery: Countries in Africa ~ Reception: Eritrea ~ Class 1: New Zealand
Class 2: India ~ Class 3: Sri Lanka ~ Class 4: Switzerland
Class 5: Japan ~ Class 6: Italy

During the week the children will learn about different aspects of that country such as

- Its location on a map
- The capital city
- The national flag and its meaning
- How to say hello in the home language
- Games that children might play there
- The main religions
- The traditional dress
