Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to advise you that a member of our school community have tested positive for COVID-19.

Since 19th July, schools are no longer responsible for identifying close contacts of persons who test positive for COVID-19. Instead, close contacts will be notified by NHS Test and Trace and given advice and instructions about isolating and / or taking a PCR test.

As schools often become aware of cases sooner than NHS Test and Trace, we are writing to inform you that there has been a person in your child's class who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Close contacts will be informed by NHS Test and Trace, but in the meantime, please be alert to the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 infection:

- A high temperature
- A new continuous cough
- A loss of change to your sense of taste or smell

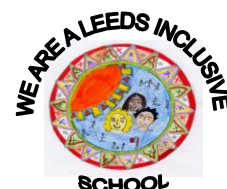
If you / your child develops one of these symptoms, please keep them at home and book a PCR test (online at: <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test> or by phoning 119 between 7am and 11pm) and stay at home until you receive a result.

The safety and welfare of all our staff and children remains our top priority. We continue to undertake thorough cleaning of the whole school and have reintroduced some of the systems we had in place before the summer holidays to continue to reduce the risk as much as possible.
